Outcomes to Achieve

- ***Inform and agree on the content of future National Illicit Firearms Assessments***
- ***Agree to the parameters of what is considered to be 'operational considerations' which would preclude jurisdictions from providing full data sets for firearms tracing and contribute to the 2013-14 and 2014-15 National Illicit Firearms Assessment; and***
- ***Agree to the creation of an 'unclassified factsheet' reflecting the key findings of any future National Illicit Firearms Reports.***

NPSOG Resolution – 11 April 2013

Agenda item 2: National response to firearms crime

NPSOG:

- Noted the update provided on the Resolutions from the June 2012 SCPEM meeting;
- Agreed to refer the proposed model and funding options for the National Firearms Interface (NFI) to SCPEM for consideration, subject to CrimTrac Board of Management endorsement;
- Noted the outcomes from the SCPEM Standing Council on Law and Justice (SCLJ) joint working group report on proposed changes to the enforcement of firearms crime;
- **Agreed to the proposed list of key data for registered and unregistered firearms to support the 2013-14 and 2015-16 ACC National Illicit Firearm Assessments, noting that in some instances operational considerations may preclude providing the full data; and**
- Noted the cost benefit analysis undertaken by the Commonwealth regarding the proposal to ballistic test all high risk firearms at the border.

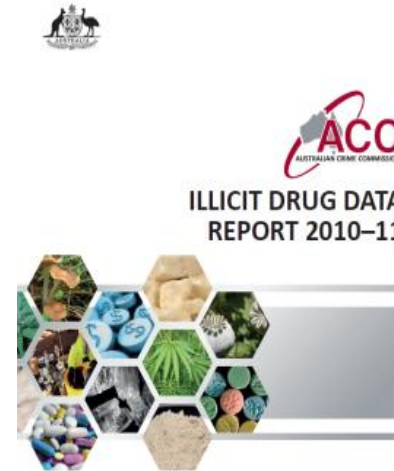
